Godspell was the first major musical theatre offering from three-time Grammy and Academy Award winner, Stephen Schwartz (*Wicked*, *Pippin*, *Children of Eden*); and it took the world by storm. We are still working on finding a rehearsal space, but you can expect that music rehearsals or smaller scenes may be at my home in Mountlake Terrace, and larger/full cast rehearsals to be at a venue somewhere in the Shoreline, Edmonds, or Lynnwood area.
