

Ballyhoo Theatre: Into the Woods

Director - Shileah Corey, Assistant Director/Choreographer - Alia Thomaier

What happens after "happily ever after?" James Lapine and Stephen Sondheim take everyone's favorite storybook characters and bring them together for a timeless, yet relevant, piece. The Tony Award-winning book and score are both enchanting and touching. The story follows a Baker and his wife, who wish to have a child; Cinderella, who wishes to attend the King's Festival; and Jack, who wishes his cow would give milk. When the Baker and his wife learn that they cannot have a child because of a Witch's curse, the two set off on a journey to break the curse. Everyone's wish is granted, but the consequences of their actions return to haunt them later with disastrous results.

Performances will be held at The Black Box Theatre at Edmonds College. This particular show will require an intensive rehearsal schedule, and very few conflicts will be allowed.

Ages 13-21 – Into the Woods is rated PG.
(We will consider actors younger than age 13 for the role of Little Red)

No one will be kept from being cast because of inability to pay tuition. Partial/full scholarships are available.

Audition requirements

Initial auditions may be either video or in-person. Video auditions are due by February 1 at 7:00pm. In person auditions are Sunday, February 1 (10:00am-1:00pm and 7:45-9:00pm). Prepare a verse/chorus (no longer than 2.5 minutes) of a song in the style of the show, Sondheim preferred. We will not be requiring a monologue, but will look at your acting through your song. A backtrack will be required. **Video Auditions:** Upload your video and email the link to ballyhoo.theatre@gmail.com. You will need to submit paperwork at the same time. **In Person Auditions:** Please email for an audition time slot at ballyhoo.theatre@gmail.com.

Callbacks are Sunday February 8 (11:00am-8:00pm – you will not be called the whole time), in person is preferred. For those unavailable, a video callback is allowed.

NOTE: This rehearsal and performance process goes over the Spring Break for Edmonds SD and Northshore SD (April 7-11), and Seattle SD (April 14-18). Students will likely not be able to participate if they are going out of town for the entire week.

Ballyhoo strives to create a casting process that is welcoming and serves those auditioning as well as the creative team in the full exploration of the material. All body types, races, ethnicities, and abilities are desired for any available role. Ballyhoo recognizes that most characters are written as binary (using he/him or she/her pronouns) and we invited GNC, genderqueer, transgender, and nonbinary actors to submit for the roles with which they identify. **ALL ROLES ARE OPEN TO ALL GENDERS!**

Into the Woods rehearsal and performance dates

Our venue for performances will be The Black Box Theatre at Edmonds College. Some rehearsals will be at Third Place Books in Lake Forest Park, but we are currently looking for a second rehearsal venue. We will rehearse in the late afternoon/evenings and some Saturdays.

Rehearsal days: Please note that the days below are only the available rehearsal days. **WE WILL NOT BE REHEARSING ALL OF THESE DATES!** This is just to see what the conflicts look like, when people can arrive after school hours, and what the best days and times are for everyone. Please know that if you have too many conflicts, I will not be able to cast you. Cross off the days that you cannot rehearse. On the days you are available, list your available hours after the date (list **all** your available hours, not just your “best” hours). We will rehearse 4-5 times per week, and the entire week that the show opens. Not everyone will be called to all rehearsals. If you have questions, ask before auditions, please. (Note: please be aware of when your Spring Break is, and figure that into your conflicts if you are going out of town part of the week.)

Roles:

The Baker – An average working person. Warm-hearted and determined but insecure, and has never faced his fears. Baritenor: A - High G.

Jack – The feckless Giant Killer, almost an adult. Eager to please and impulsive. A little slow of learning, and misled by his lack of self-knowledge. Tenor: A - High G.

Narrator/Mysterious Man – Intellectual and pleasant. A good storyteller who relates directly with the audience. Mysterious Man: A mischievous person with a secret. Baritone: G - High E

Cinderella's Prince – Vain, gorgeous, self-dramatizing and endlessly confident. A hero in his own life's story. Tenor: B - High F

Rapunzel's Prince – Just as vain, gorgeous, etc as his older brother. Strives endlessly to be beat him in all things. Baritone: C sharp - High E.

Wolf – (Usually doubles with another role) Hungry and insatiable. Charming. Baritenor: B - High G flat.

Steward – Surly and bureaucratic, full of self-importance. May double with another role.

Cinderella's Father - A drinker, out of touch with his family but harmless and well-meaning. May double with another role.

Milky White – The cow. Sad and sickly. Milky white will be pupeted, and we need a strong physical actor to portray this character. Includes vocalization.

The Baker's Wife – Determined and bright. A romantic at heart, but materialistic at times. Mezzo-Soprano: G - High F.

The Witch – Outwardly self-serving, possessive, sarcastic, vain, charismatic. Inwardly insecure and lonely. Mezzo-Soprano: Low F - High F.

Cinderella – Earnest, warm-hearted, kind, and trying to find her place in the world. A survivor. Soprano: G - High G.

Little Red Riding Hood – A spoiled, clever, vain, smarty-pants. Seeks approval in place of love, of which she has had none. Mezzo-Soprano: B - High F.

Rapunzel – A maiden who is completely and utterly innocent of worldly matters and drifts through life. Strong legit soprano. Soprano: C - High A sharp.

Jack's Mother – A single mother and a fighter, working hard and determined to make a good life for her hapless son. Mezzo-Sop: B - High F sharp.

Stepmother – Mean-spirited, greedy and demanding. Mezzo-Soprano: A # - High F.

Florinda – Cinderella's stepsister, lovely but black of heart. Mezzo-Soprano: C - High E.

Lucinda – Cinderella's stepsister, lovely but black of heart. Mezzo-Soprano: C - High E.

Granny – Bitter and vindictive, she is Little Red's feisty, savage, knife-wielding grandmother. (Usually doubles with another role)

Cinderella's Mother – Nurturing and loving. A spirit, who dispenses useful advice. Soprano. (Usually doubles with another role).

Snow White/Ensemble – Small walk on role. (May double with another role).

Sleeping Beauty/Ensemble – Small walk on role. (May double with another role).

Female Giant – Loud, angry, offstage (or recorded) voice only. Will double with another role.
