The music, based on the rural folk music of the Great Lakes and Southern Appalachia, imparts a simplicity that is truly beautiful.

What to Prepare:

Please prepare 32 bars (or verse/chorus) of a song in the style of the show that displays your vocal range, and a short monologue. Audition time limit is 4 minutes maximum. You may choose to do your initial audition via video if you like, or you can sign up for an in-person slot. Video audition deadline is June 1 at 4:00pm. In person auditions are Sunday, June 1, with in-person callbacks Sunday, June 8. Video callbacks are acceptable if you are unable to come in person.

CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

Age ranges reflect the ages of the characters, not necessarily the actors playing those characters.

Percy Talbott: (Early 20s) Percy has the strength of her youth and a sadness beyond her years. She carries a terrible secret. Her accent has a southern Appalachian cadence. Strong folk/country belt/mix belt to D, some head voice required. \$500.00 stipend

Hannah Ferguson: (Age 65-75) Hannah is the owner of the Spitfire Grill. She is a tough-skinned and flinty old bird with a short, no-nonsense manner bordering on the bitter. She can also be very tender-hearted and fiercely loyal. She has a secret of her own to protect. Alto. \$500.00 stipend

Shelby Thorpe: (Age range 28-38) Shelby has a shy, almost ethereal manner. She is the wife of Caleb Thorpe. Once her trust is gained, she also is a very loyal friend. Folk soprano with strong high belt/mix belt to D. \$500.00 stipend

Caleb Thorpe: (Age range 30-45) Caleb is the out-of-work foreman of the now-defunct stone quarry, and is a frustrated man clinging to the past and the authority he once had. He bitterly opposes change. Solid folk/rock voice with an edge (Top G). \$500.00 stipend

Sheriff Joe Sutter: *NOTE: This role is already cast* – (Age range mid-late 20s) Joe is a young, small-town policeman with an appealing intensity and a restless nature. Strong folk tenor to a G (touches an A). \$500.00 stipend

Effy Crayneck: (Age range 35+) Effy is postmistress and the town busybody. She is a woman with a sour tongue. There's little to gossip about in a town so small, but when there is, she is the source. Mezzo/alto chest range. \$350.00 stipend (Needed for a few rehearsals until pre-tech)

The Visitor: (Age range late 30s/early 40s) The visitor is a mysterious figure who never speaks, has powerful eyes and a very strong sense of his body. \$200.00 stipend (Needed for very few rehearsals until pre/tech) Non-singing/non-speaking role

Understudies: Will receive a stipend based on which characters and how many characters they understudy.
